Travis is looking after snow removal. If you'd like him to clear your driveway, you can contact him at 902-277-0405.

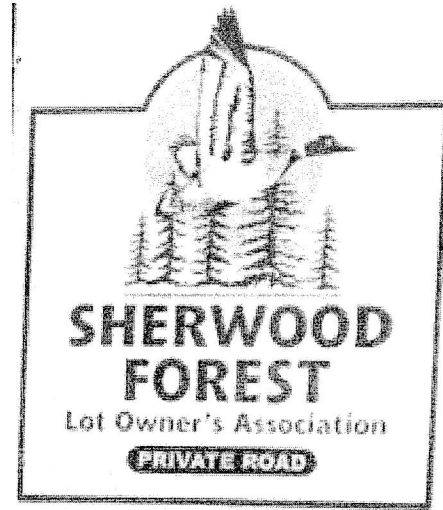
Association Annual General Meeting and Summer Party
