Each property is responsible for the removal of excess brush in front of their properties. Brushing ensures...

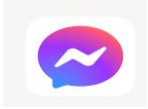
- √ there are clear sight lines
- √ the roadway width is protected during snow removal
- √ access for ditching and culvert repair

Road Maintenance Update



- Road brushing and brush removal was completed in the fall by Gates Property & Forest Management. The total cost was \$2280
- Videos of the completed road work are on the website at <https://sherwoodforestloa.com> Password is *sherwood* (not case sensitive)
- Recently, a sinkhole was reported on the roadway, the culvert was removed and a new one installed within a day of being reported. The total cost was \$1898.10
- Executive will meet with Clyde Zinck to determine what regular/annual road maintenance will be required going forward
- Gravel will be applied to the road in the spring, after frost has gone from ground and vehicle weight restrictions have been lifted
